Sunday - Gents shoot a Long National
Ladies and U18 Junior Boys shoot a National
U16 boys and U18 girls shoot a Short National
U14 boys and U16 girls shoot a Junior national
U12 boys and U14 girls and shoot a Short Junior National

Archers may enter any round they wish, but they will only be eligible for medals if they enter the appropriate round.

Novice Definition

A Novice for this shoot is defined as any archer who is in their first year of GNAS registration.

Please see the separate entry form for the DNAA Championships.

Entries for the national round from experienced archers who wish to shoot to break the national record will be accepted but they will not be eligible for the novice awards.

Directions

From the North- Go through the Tyne Tunnel and down the A19. Take the exit marked Boldon Colliery. At the traffic lights turn right. At the next set by the Boldon Lad Pub turn left.

Follow the road through the traffic calming and turn right at the roundabout. Then first left signposted "Hedworth Community Association". Drive straight into the CA and follow the parking signs to the back of the car park. Park under the direction of the stewards.

From the South- take the A19 to the Boldon Colliery exit. At the top of the ramp turn right. Then turn left at the traffic light by the Boldon Lad Pub. Then as per the above paragraph.
